




Clover Appliqué Template Block

Appliqué Instructions

This size design is best used on an 18 x 18 square ... it can be a pillow, a quilt, a bag or anything else you can think of!!

Step 1

Cut out the pattern pieces, Lay the pattern pieces right side up on your fabric, pin, and cut out your fabric

Step 2

Pin your pieces to your background fabric. Be sure you like the placement because this is what your design will look like when you're done

Step 3

You are going to zig zag on top of your applique pieces close to edge of your fabric all the way around twice. I change the color of my thread to match the color of the fabric but you can use white if you want. It's important that you sew around two times so that your applique doesn't come off after many washings



Raised Applique Instructions

You will need flannel, cotton for your appliqué design and a sewing machine

Step 1

Cut out the pattern pieces , Lay the pattern pieces right side up on your fabric , pin, and cut out your fabric

Step 2

Pin your pieces to your flannel. Be sure you like the placement because this is what your design will look like when you're done

Step 3

You are going to sew on top of your applique pieces close to edge of your fabric all the way around. I change the color of my thread to match the color of the fabric but you can use white if you want. if you're using a straight stitch you only have to go around once but if you choose to zig zag you'll need to go around twice. . The very outside stitch of your applique can be straight stitched. all the way around.

step 4

Cut the applique out close to the edge

Step5


Pun your applique to the front of your shirt and straight stitch all the way around

Step back and look at what you've created


