Gnome-Grown

Panel Quilt: 45" x 64"



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Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. WOF = width of fabric.
All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 5-1/2" x 69" and (2) 5-1/2" x 50" gnome stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (4) 3" strips. Sew 2 strips together end to end and cut (1) 3" x 46-1/2" and (1) 3" x 27-1/2" borders. Repeat for a total of 2 each length border.

Fabric D - Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (4) 3" squares and (8) 2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (4) 2" strips. Sew 2 strips together end to end and cut (1) 2" x 43-1/2" and (1) 2" x 24-1/2" borders. Repeat for a total of 2 each length border.

Fabric F - Cut (3) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 51-1/2" borders
Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 32-1/2" borders
Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 26" strips
Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips

Fabric G - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

2. Piecing Order:

1. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, squares, and borders.

2. Stitch **Fabric F** 1-1/2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-3/4" x 26" **Fabric F** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 24-1/2" x 43-1/2" (unfinished).**

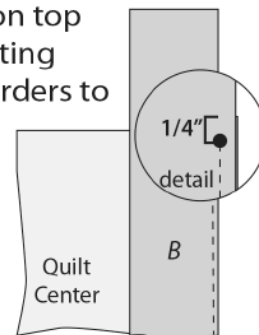
*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*

3. Sew **Fabric E** 2" x 43-1/2" borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Stitch **Fabric D** 2" squares to both short ends of each **Fabric E** 2" x 24-1/2" border. Add these to top and bottom of bordered panel.

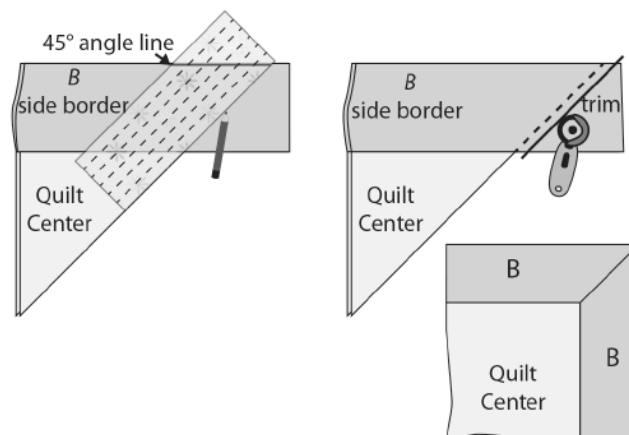
4. Sew **Fabric C** 3" x 46-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Stitch **Fabric D** 3" squares to both short ends of each **Fabric C** 3" x 27-1/2" border. Add these to top and bottom of quilt.

5. Sew **Fabric F** 2" x 51-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Stitch **Fabric D** 2" squares to both short ends of each **Fabric F** 2" x 32-1/2" border. Add these to top and bottom of quilt.

6. Center **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 69" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 50" borders on top and bottom of quilt center noting orientation of stripe. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



7. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



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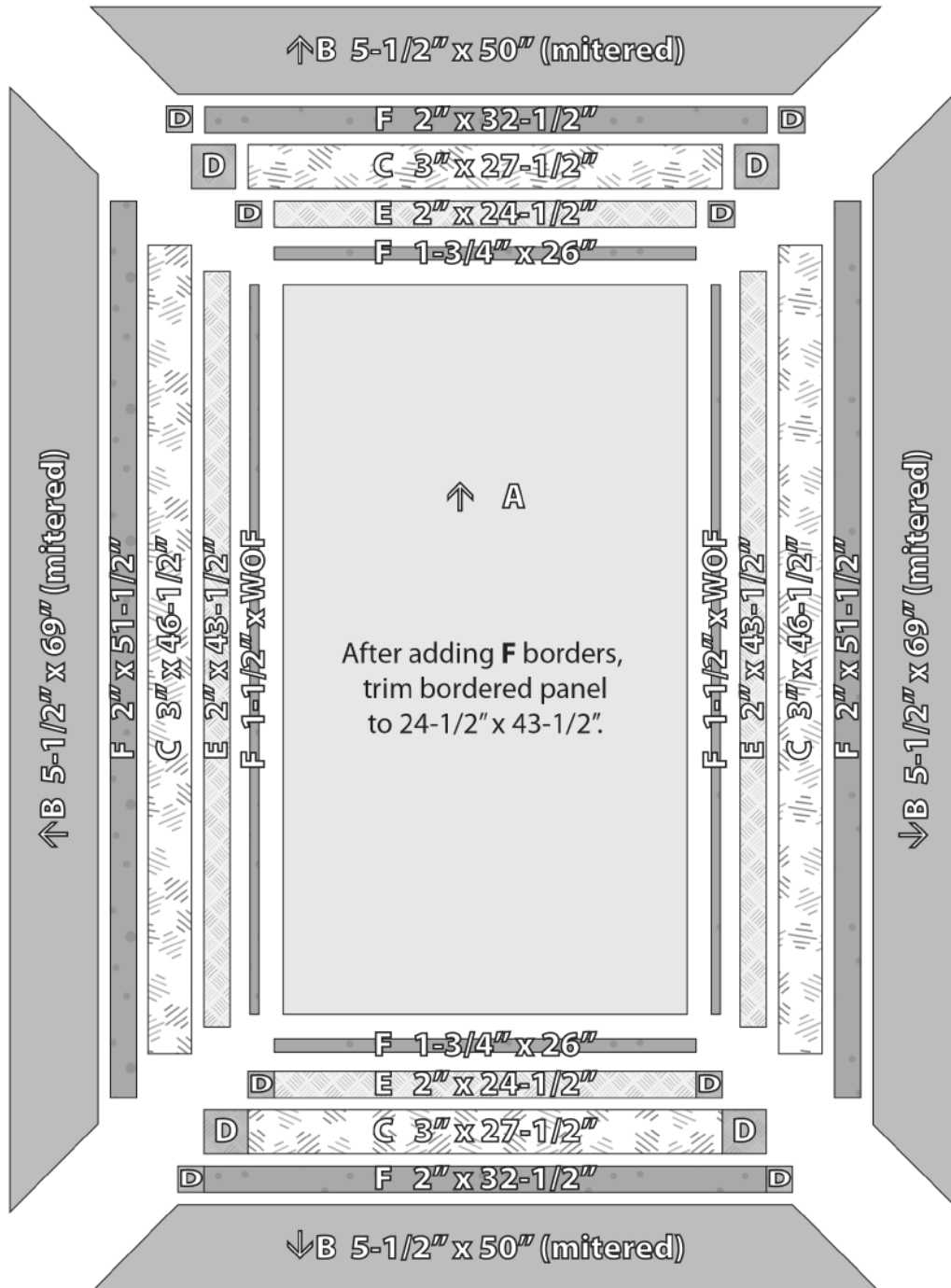
8. The quilt measures approximately 45-1/2" x 64-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric H**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

9. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!
