Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

# **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The projects portrayed are virtual images. The looks of the projects may be different with actual fabric. The project virtual(s) shown may be different than the image shown on the actual cover. Backing yardage is shown using the best use of fabric and may not be intended for directional fabric

Please note that prewashing can shrink your fabric. Always verify after washing and drying that there is still 42" of usable width available. Shrinkage can affect the size of panel motifs and fussy cutting sizes may need to be adjusted. If this is the case, add strips around the edge of the fussy cut piece to create a pieced unit that matches the size of the fussy cut dimensions given in the cutting instructions.

WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together SNF = Stitch and Flip

#### OTHER SUPPLIES

2 yards Wide Back backing fabric (WB14203-WHITE Grid suggested) Batting (68" x 68") Basic sewing supplies

#### **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

Please read all pattern instructions before cutting fabrics. Label all cuts as noted below.









#### **Keep Blooming Panel**

Cut (4) squares from panel at 16 ½" x 16 ½", centering the images.



#### **Yellow Daisies**

Cut (10) 2" squares. Label as A.



#### **Periwinkle Stems**

Cut (8) 2" squares. Label as B.



#### **Periwinkle Geometric**

Cut (10) 2" squares. Label as C.



## **Raspberry Geometric**

Cut (5) 2" squares. Label as D.



#### **Yellow Gingham**

Cut (8) 2" squares. Label as E.



#### **Cloud Main**

Cut (12) 5" squares. Label as F.



#### **Black Main**

Cut (8) 5" squares. Label as G.



#### **Green Ditsy**

Cut (20) 3 1/4" squares. Label as H.



#### **Green Geometric**

Cut (20) 2 3/4" squares. Label as I.



#### **Raspberry Gingham**

Cut (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips, set aside for binding

Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip; subcut:

(4) 2" squares. Label as J.

Cut (5) 1 %" x WOF strips; sew together end-to-end and subcut:

- (2) 1 ½" x 48 ½" strips. Label as K.
- (2) 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips. Label as L.



#### All the Pink Blossom

Cut (9) 1 3/4" x WOF strips; subcut:

- (10) 1 3/4" x 14" rectangles. Label as M.
- (10) 1 3/4" x 16 1/2" rectangles. Label as N.

Cut (4) 2 ¾" x WOF strips; subcut:

(60) 2 3/4" squares. Label as O.

Cut (2) 3 1/4" x WOF strips; subcut:

(20) 3 1/4" squares. Label as P.



#### Periwinkle Main

Cut (6) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew together end-to-end, then subcut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 50 ½" strips. Label as Q.
- (2) 5 ½" x 60 ½" strips. Label as R.

#### **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Sew with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise stated. Refer to the quilt photo for placement of the prints. Press seams open unless otherwise stated.

#### STITCH AND FLIP METHOD (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the smaller piece across the corner. Stitch on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance above the sewn line to  $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Flip the small piece away from the bottom piece and press, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.



#### STITCH AND FLIP UNITS (SNF UNIT)

1. Using the SNF method, sew (2) O squares to the upper corners of (1) F square. Repeat to make a total of (12) Cloud SNF Units.









2. Using the SNF method, sew (2) O squares to the upper corners of (1) G square. Repeat to make a total of (8) Black SNF Units.











#### **NINE-PATCH BLOCK**

3. To make (1) Nine-Patch Unit, gather (5) A squares and (4) E squares. Sew together the rows by alternating A squares and E squares. Refer to the diagram below for placement. Press toward E squares. Repeat to make a total of (2) Yellow Nine-Patch Units. The unit should measure 5" x 5".



4. Repeat Step 3 to make (2) Periwinkle Nine-Patch Units and (1) Raspberry Nine-Patch Unit.



#### 2-AT-A-TIME HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLES (HST)

5. Gather (1) P square and (1) H square; place RST. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Stitch ¼" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to create (2) HSTs. Press open. Trim HSTs to 2 ¾". Repeat to make a total of (40) P/H HSTs.













#### MAIN BLOCK ASSEMBLY


- 6. Gather (4) O squares, (8) P/H HSTs, (4) I squares, (4) Cloud SNF Units, and (1) Yellow Nine-Patch Unit.
- 7. Make the 4 Corner Units first, then sew together each row as shown in the diagram below. Press seams open. The block should measure 14" x 14".




8. Sew an M rectangle to each side of the block from the previous step. Press seams toward the M rectangles. Then sew an N rectangle to the top and bottom of the block. Press seams toward N rectangles. The block should measure 16 ½" x 16 ½". Repeat to make a total of (2) Yellow Main Blocks.



9. Repeat steps 6-8 using the Black SNF units and the Periwinkle Nine-Patch Units to create (2) Periwinkle Main Blocks.



10. Repeat steps 6-8 using the Cloud SNF units and the Raspberry Nine-Patch Unit to create (1) Raspberry Main Block.



# **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

11. Sew rows together, alternating between Main Blocks and Panel Squares to complete the quilt center. The quilt center should measure 48 ½" x 48 ½".



# **INNER BORDER**

12. Sew a K strip to each side of the quilt center. Then sew an L strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. The quilt center should now measure 50 %" x 50 %".



#### **OUTER BORDER**

13. Sew a Q strip to each side of the quilt center. Then sew an R strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. The quilt should now measure 60 %" x 60 %".



# FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Bind with the 2 ½" Raspberry Gingham strips.
