

WILMINGTON EPints

Throw Quilt: 59" x 77"

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

- **Fabric A** Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 5" x 78" (1 floral, 1 moths) and (2) 5" x 60" (1 floral, 1 moths) stripe borders
- **Fabric B** Cut (2) 9-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 9-1/2" squares
- **Fabric C** Cut (3) 9-1/2" strips, subcut (10) 9-1/2" squares. From remainder of strip, fussy cut (5) 3-1/2" squares with a motif centered
- **Fabric D** Cut (3) 2" strips, from 1 strip cut (2) 2" x 21" strips
- Fabric E Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut
 (2) 3-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally for a total of 4 triangles] and
 (4) 2" squares
 - Cut (3) 2" strips, from 1 strip cut (2) 2" x 21" strips
- **Fabric F** Cut (3) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (36) 3-1/2" squares
 - Cut (3) 4" strips, subcut (24) 4" squares
 - Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (40) 2" squares
- Fabric G Cut (1) 4" strip, subcut (8) 4" squares Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (32) 2" squares
- Cut (7) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 75" and (2) 1-3/4" x 60" borders
- **Fabric H** Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (20) 3-1/2" squares and (4) 2" squares Cut (2) 2" strips
- Fabric I Cut (2) 4" strips, subcut (16) 4" squares and (8) 2" squares
- Fabric J Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (20) 3-1/2" squares and (4) 2-3/8" squares Cut (1) 2-3/8" strip, subcut (16) 2-3/8" squares then cut all (20) 2-3/8" squares in half diagonally for a total of 40 triangles
- Cut (3) 2" strips
- Cut (6) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 63-1/2" and (2) 1-3/4" x 48" borders

- Fabric K Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (16) 3-1/2" squares Cut (2) 2" strips, from 1 strip subcut (16) 2" squares
- Fabric L Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut
 (8) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for a total of 16 triangles
 Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
 Cut (2) 2" strips
 - Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 21" strips and (16) 2" squares

2. Piecing Order:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all the **Fabrics F**, **G**, **H**, **I**, and **K** 2" squares and **Fabrics F**, **H**, and **K** 3-1/2" squares.




Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. On the wrong side of all **Fabric F** 4" squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.



3. Arrange 2 **Fabric F** and 1 each **Fabrics H** and **K** marked 3-1/2" squares on corners of a **Fabric B** 9-1/2" squares as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out to





complete **Block 1a** (9-1/2" square unfinished).

4. In the same manner, make 1 each **Blocks 1b-1j** and 2 each **Blocks 1k-1n** with fabrics indicated.

5. Arrange 1 each marked **Fabrics F** and **I** 2" squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric J** 3-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Repeat on remaining corners as shown. Make a total of 4 Unit 1a (3-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 1 Unit 1b, 16 Unit 1c, and 4 Unit 1d with fabrics indicated.

6. Stitch 2 **Fabric J** 2-3/8" triangles to adjoining edges of a **Fabric E** 2" square. Add a **Fabric E** 3-7/8" triangle. Make a total of 4 Unit 2a (3-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 16 Unit 2b with fabrics indicated.

7. Arrange a marked **Fabric F** 4" square right sides together with a **Fabric I** 4" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 3-1/2" square. Make a total of 32 Unit 3a. In the same manner, make a total of 16 Unit 3b with fabrics indicated.












Repeat 16 times for 32 units.

Unit 3a Make 32


Unit 3b Make 16

8. Stitch 1 each **Fabrics E** and **H** 2" x 42" strips together lengthwise. Make 2 strip sets. From these, cut (32) 2" wide Unit 4a (2" x 3-1/2" unfinished).




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9. In the same manner, make the number of strip sets required and cut into the number of Units 4b-4g with fabrics indicated. For 32 units make (2) 42" strips sets. For 16 units make (1) 42" strip set. For 8 units make (1) 21" strip set.



10. Stitch 2 Unit 4a together, alternating fabrics. Make a total of 16 Unit 5a (3-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 5b-5g listed with units indicated.






11. Arrange 4 Unit 1a, 1 Unit 1b, and 4 Unit 2a in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 2a** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



12. In the same manner, make 4 each **Blocks 2b**, **3a**, **3b**, and **3c** with units indicated.



- 13. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 5) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- 14. Arrange blocks in 7 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (45-1/2" x 63-1/2" unfinished).
- 15. Sew **Fabric J** 1-3/4" x 63-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric J** 1-3/4" x 48" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 16. Center **Fabric A** 5" x 78" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric A** 5" x 60" borders on top and bottom of quilt center noting orientation of stripe. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



17. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.




- 18. Sew **Fabric G** 1-3/4" x 75" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric G** 1-3/4" x 59-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 19. The quilt measures approximately 59-1/2" x 77-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric M**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 20. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric K**) and enjoy!!
