## Fabric Requirements

1<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yards Fleur-C7970 Black  
3/4 yard Butterfly-C7975 Cream  
5/8 yard Fleur-C7974 Black  
1/3 yard Fleur-C7976 Black  
1/4 yard Fleur-C7973 Black  
1/2 yard Fleur-C7977 Green (binding)  
3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yards backing of your choice  
58" × 70" batting

## Cutting

### *From Fleur-C7970 Black:*

- Cut two 11<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × width-of-fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut six 11<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares
- Cut six 5" × WOF strips for outer border.

### *From Butterfly-C7975 Cream:*

- Cut sixteen 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × WOF strips. Sub-cut three 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 35<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips, two 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 25<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips and four 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 11<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips. Set remaining strips aside for narrow borders.

### *From Fleur-C7974 Black:*

- Cut five 4" × WOF strips.

### *From Fleur-C7976 Black:*

- Cut four 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × WOF strips.

### *From Fleur-C7973 Black:*

- Cut one 4" × WOF strip. Sub-cut four 4" squares.

### *From Fleur-C7977 Green:*

- Cut six 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × WOF strips for binding.

## Quilt Top Assembly

*All seam allowances are 1/4" and pieces are sewn right side together.*

1. Lay out the six 11<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C7970 Black squares in two columns of three blocks each.
2. Sew one 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 11<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C7975 Cream strip between the three blocks to make a column. Repeat to complete the second column.
3. Sew one 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 35<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C7975 Cream strip between the two columns, aligning adjacent block seams. Sew one 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 35<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C7975 Cream strip to each side of the center blocks.
4. Sew one 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 25<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C7975 Cream strip to the top and other to the bottom of the center blocks.
5. Sew together the 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × WOF C7976 Black strips end to end. Measure the quilt center length and cut two strips to that measurement. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt.
6. Measure the quilt center width and cut two 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C7976 Black strips that measurement. Sew one strip to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt.
7. Repeat steps 5 and 6 using the remaining 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C7975 Cream strips to make and apply the next border.
8. Sew together the 4" × WOF C7974 Black strips end to end. Measure the quilt center width and cut two strips that length. Sew one 4" C7973 Black square to each end of each cut C7974 Black strip and set aside.
9. Measure the quilt center length and cut two C7974 Black strips that measurement. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt.
10. Sew one of the C7974 Black strips with cornerstones from step 8 to the top and other to the bottom of the quilt top.
11. Repeat steps 5 and 6 using remaining 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C7975 Cream strip to make and apply the next border.
12. Repeat steps 5 and 6 using six 5" × WOF C7970 Black strips to make and apply the outer border.



## Finishing

13. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing, and quilt as desired.
14. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
15. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
